We have rescued 17 animals this month and also found good homes for 7 pups & 1 kitten. We could not conduct any birth control surgeries due to lack of veterinarians during this month.			
2	Birthday of HAS - 06-04-2020	Proud moment for having completed another year of service to animals. Over the last 14 years, we have aided over 55000 animals. With the support of the Management team, Staff, Volunteers, Donors and public support, this has been achieved and growing stronger year after year.			
3	Work continues in Pandemic situation	Throughout In the Pandemic situation, everyone suffered a lot; especially dogs, cats and cows wandering in the streets suffered immeasurably without their regular sources of food. Many of them were at risk of dying from starvation. Team HAS along with hundreds of volunteers, and kind public, gave a helping hand to these animals by providing food and water. We conducted many rescues and spot treatments for as many animals as we could. We had almost 200 animals on an average to look after every day. Despite the pandemic situation, our dedicated staff continued to work, giving support and love to the resident animals. We are very thankful to all our supporters during this tough month.

A Stray dog that was brutally killed by a migrant worker under the instructions of an elder guy in Peelamedu also got justice. After this case came into the limelight that culprit was arrested. While we are grateful for the actions taken by activists and police for these two cases, we realize that there is a long and winding road ahead for animals to get their due justice				
3	Vaccination drives	We are carried out numerous ARV drives in several local areas in Coimbatore. A unique rabies drive was carried out in vadavally after a dog that was rescued, died of Rabies. Team HAS along with the Pawsome volunteers and local community people vaccinated several pets and community animals. Our Team created awareness about Rabies and its prevention. We also conducted another vaccination drive in the area of Saibaba Colony as a preventive measure against Canine distemper where sevaral pets received Multi-Component Vaccination.
