

Puppies find new homes

COIMBATORE: Many people who came to the puppy adoption camp organised by Humane Animal Society went back disappointed as the puppies available were adopted before they arrived.

Around 30 mongrels were adopted at the camp held at the Lakshmi Mills Junction. According to Mini Vasudevan, managing trustee, Humane Animal Society, the NGO would provide free treatment and vaccination to the adopted dogs according to requirements.

Vaccination

All the puppies were vaccinated and they would be sterilised at an appropriate time.

Ms. Vasudevan said that those who had approached the organisation during the camp would be informed when puppies were available for adoption. According to her, encouraging adoption of mongrels would help discourage commercial breeding of dogs where they faced cruel treatment.
