Coimbatore: About 500 children from 12 schools participated in the citizen's march organized by India Green and Wild along with Humane Animal Society on Saturday at Race Course.

The march, which began at the Income Tax office around 10am, had children holding posters and placards against some of the major issues the nation faces—deforestation, greed, intensive farming, encroachment and exploitation.

The movement was launched across the country by involving about 250 schools across 50 cities, the organisers said. It reached out to schools so that children and teachers are made aware of the major issues
